#### History:

1. David was youngest of eight sons, v. 14
2. A shepherd and musician to Saul, v.15 & 1 Sam. 16:14-23
3. Left the sheep with a keeper, v.20
4. Trusted by his father
5. Left his supplies with the supply keeper, v. 22
6. Became informed, vs. 25-27
7. Accused but did not get distracted, vs. 28-30
  - a. Accused of pride, insolence, small person (small job) v. 28
  - b. Accused by his brother before, "what have I done now?" v. 29 & 1 Sam. 16:7-13
8. David, "Is there not a cause?"
9. David, let no one fear I will go.
10. David protected his sheep by going after the lion and bear and killed them, vs 34-37
11. David said "God will deliver me"
12. David commissioned by the king, v.37
13. Stay true to yourself, vs. 38-39

#### The Battle:

1. David taking his authority – his staff, v. 40
2. The sling the Word of God
3. David, I come in the name of the LORD, v. 45
4. David, the battle is the LORD's, v. 47
5. David, ran to the battle, v. 48
  - a. David, prevailed, vs. 48-50
  - b. The promotion, vs. 55-58
