

## History to the story:

1. It starts in earnest with the resurrection of Lazarus in Bethany about four to five months before the crucifixion of Christ, John 11:1-44.
2. The Chief Priest and other leaders plot to kill Jesus so He leaves the area and heads to Samaria and Galilee, John 11: 45-54; Luke 17:11.
3. He heals the ten lepers, Luke 17:12-19
4. Lessons on the Coming Kingdom, Luke 17:20-37
5. Parable on being persistent with God, Luke 18: 1-8, "And shall God not avenge His own elect, who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? V. 7 "I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
6. Parable of the prayers of the Pharisee and the tax collector, Luke 18:9-14 "...for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."
7. Jesus speaks on the doctrine of divorce in the region of Perea, Matthew 19:1-12; Mark 10: 1-12.
8. Jesus blesses the children in Perea & speaks to the rich young ruler, Matthew 19:13-30; Mark 10:13-31; Luke 18: 15-30.
9. Jesus foretells His Death and Resurrection near the Jordan & the ambition of James and John, Matthew 20:17-28; Mark 32-45; Luke 18:31-34.
10. Jesus travels to Jericho where He heals Blind Bartimaeus, Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43.
11. Jesus speaks with Zacchaeus and gives the parable of the Minas, Luke 19:1-27.
12. He returns to the home of Mary and Martha in Bethany where the Chief Priest and other leaders plot to kill him, John 11:55-12:11. This probably happened the last few days of winter.
13. Triumphal Entry: He came from Bethany to Jerusalem and returned to Bethany that evening, Matt. 21:1-9; Mark 11: 1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19. March or April of 30 A.D.

## THE MULTITUDE'S PRAISE

The group from Jerusalem – John 12:12-13 came out of Jerusalem to meet him crying out **Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! The King of Israel!**

The colt was gathered while He was near Bethpage and Bethany on the of Mt. Olivet- Luke 19:28-40. (He left Bethany so He probably got the colt from Bethpage. While standing there the crowds were gathered behind him and the crowds were coming to Him from Jerusalem shouting praise. Verse 37 the two groups came together saying "**Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!**")

Jesus' heart break Luke 19:41-48

Mark 11:9-10, "...**Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that comes in the name of the LORD! Hosanna in the highest!**"

Matthew 21:9, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! Hosanna in the highest!"
