#### PETER'S INTRODUCTION TO JESUS, John 1:29-34

## All four Gospels records Jesus's baptism

- 1. John's Gospel is the only one that does not record the temptation of Jesus in the wilderness for forty days.
- 2. Only John records the introduction of the first disciples on the other side of the Jordan, Jn. 1:35-51
  - a. Andrew, v. 40 & another.
  - b. Peter, vs. 40-42
  - c. Philip & Nathanael vs. 43-51
  - d. Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, v. 43
- 3. Jesus went to a wedding with His disciples, Jn. 1-11 (only recorded in John)
  - a. V.12 Jesus probably leased His future house in Capernaum.
- 4. Jesus and His disciples go to the Passover in Jerusalem, vs. 13-25
  - a. Jesus cleanses the temple, vs. 14-22.
  - b. Jesus did many signs, v. 23.
- 5. Jesus and John the Baptist baptize, Jn. 3:22-36
  - a. "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure." V. 34
  - b. Jesus leaves Judea, because or the pharisees, and heads to Galilee via Samaria, Jn. 4:1
  - c. Jesus & disciples came to Cana of Galilee where he healed the nobleman's son, Jn. 4:46-54

## PETER'S CALL TO FISH FOR MEN, Matthew 4:17-22

- 1. He saw all kinds of people healed, vs. 23-25
  - a. A demoniac healed on the Sabbath Day, Mark 1:21-28; Luke 4:31-37
  - b. Peters mother-in-law was healed.
  - c. Lepers were healed, Mark 1: 40-42
  - d. Paralytic carried by for healed, Mark 2:1-12
  - e. Levi called, Mark 2:13-28
  - f. Jesus goes to His second Passover with His disciples in Jerusalem, Jn. 5:1-47
    - a. Man with an infirmity for 38 years healed, vs. 3-9,14.
  - g. Man with a withered hand healed in Galilee, Luke 6:6-10
  - h. Multitudes healed by sea of Galilee, the disciples home area. They may have known many of these people. Luke 6:17-19

# PETER CALLED TO JESUS, APPOINTED - APOSTLE LUKE 6:12-15

- 1. Peter listened to the famous parables, Luke 4-18; Mark 4:1-34; Matthew13:1-52
- 2. Peter saw the Gadarene demoniac healed, Matthew 8:28-34
- 3. He saw Jairus' daughter healed and the women with an issue of blood healed, Matthew 9:18-26
- 4. Muted demoniac healed, Matthew 9:27-31
- 5. The twelve sent out, Luke 9:1-6

6. Feeding of the 5000, Matthew 14:16-21

### THE MAN WHO WALKED ON WATER, Matthew 14:24-33

- 1. 3-4 miles out in the sea in a major storm.
- 2. Wind and waves were contrary to them, v. 24
- 3. Late night between 3-6 in the morning
- 4. They think they see a ghost, v.26
- 5. Jesus said," Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid."
- 6. Command me or bid me, to urge on, to incite by word. Strong's 2753.
- 7. Jesus said, "come." V. 29
- 8. Peter came down out of the boat and walked on the water to go to Jesus. V. 29
- 9. Took his eyes off Jesus, became afraid, and began to sink, he cried out to Jesus.
- 10. Jesus immediately stretched out His hand and caught him.
- 11. Why did you doubt? V. 31
- 12. Once Jesus got into the boat the wind ceased.
