1. They will cast out demons, v.17
2. They will speak with new tongues
3. They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them, v.18
4. They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover, v.18

#### JOHN'S ACCOUNTS OF THOSE THINGS THAT FOLLOWED JESUS

1. Jesus' first miracle was not His choice but his mother's, John 2:3-11. I believe her faith caused Father to smile and Jesus to respond.
  - a. Jesus - my hour has not come, v.4
  - b. Mother – said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."
2. Nicodemus seeks out Christ because he knows Jesus was sent from God because of the signs He has done, John 3:1-8. There was anointing in His teachings.
  - a. We need to be born of the spirit, vs. 5, 6
  - b. V. 8 we become like the wind we go wherever the Spirit directs.
  - c. V. 34 "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure."
3. John 4:23, 24 the true worshipper worship in spirit and truth. The emptying of self and filling up with God.
4. The nobleman from Capernaum went to Cana to ask Jesus to heal his son, John 4:46-54
5. The man healed at the pool of Bethesda, John 5:1-15
  - a. V. 6 "Do you want to be made well?"
  - b. "Rise, take up your bed and walk." V.8
  - c. V. 14 "Sin no more," This is one-time Jesus connects the ailment with sin. Cp. John 9: 1-4
  - d. John 5:19-20.
    1. Can't do anything of Himself nor us.
    2. Do what we see the Father do
    3. "In like manner"
6. John 6:63 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."
7. John 7:38,39
