2. 2 Timothy 1:6-7 “Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of hands. For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”
3. 1 Timothy 4:1-16
4. Isaiah 43:18-19 “Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.”
5. Isaiah 44:21
6. Psalms 25:7 “Do not remember the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; according to Your mercy remember me, for Your goodness’ sake, o Lord.”

REMEMBER YOUR CREATOR, Ecclesiastes 12:1, 6-14

1. “Remember now your Creator in the days of your youth, before the difficult days come, and the years draw near when you say, ‘I have no pleasure in them’”
2. 1 Corinthians 11:24-25 “do this in remembrance of Me”
3. John 14:26 “But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you,”

Last Words: Philippians 4:8 “Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy – meditate on these things.”
