

DISCIPLES OWE NOBODY ANYTHING VS. 8-10

1. Greek present tense "Don't continue owing anything to anybody."
2. Be indebted to love one another.
 - a. Matthew 5:43-48
 - b. Matthew 19:19 spoken first in Leviticus 19:18
 - c. Matthew 22:36-40 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the law? Jesus said to him, you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: you shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."
 - d. Galatians 5:13-15 "For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another!"
3. Love is the fulfillment of the law, vs. 9, 10. Let's not be tied to this world a better one is ours.

DISCIPLES KNOW THE TIMES, VS. 11 – 12A

1. Love knowing the time (the nearness of the coming of the Lord and the difficulties ahead).
2. Wake (up) out of sleep, out of a stupor.
3. Our (final) salvation is near.
4. That day is at hand.

DISCIPLES WALK PROPERLY, VS. 12b -14

1. "Cast off the works of darkness"
2. "Put on the armor of light"
3. "Let us walk properly, as in the day" (like Christ is coming today), v. 13
 - a. Not in revelry (partying), in drunkenness, in lewdness, in lust, in strife, in envy.
4. Put on Christ – let Him clothe you with His presents.
5. "Make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts"

Last word: "Today is the day of salvation" let's respond to him.
