1. Grace and faith is given by God to all, v. 3

 - B. Ministry – to run on errands, attendant, waiter
 - C. Teacher – many types and places to teach
 - D. Exhorter – to call near, invite, beseech or implore
 - E. Giver – give or share
 - F. Leader –to stand before, be out front
 - G. Mercy – compassionate, divine grace
